



Flooding & Severe Storms

Community Supply Donation Guide

When flooding or severe storms strike, KBT-ESF stages at accessible community locations to support affected residents with resource distribution and welfare checks. The items below are what we can most effectively use and distribute during an active response. Sealed packaging and good condition are important — please do not donate expired or damaged goods.

WATER & NUTRITION

- **Bottled water**

Individual bottles or sealed cases — the single most-needed item in any flood response.

- **Electrolyte drinks**

Gatorade, Pedialyte, or similar. Especially important for elderly individuals and children.

- **Non-perishable snack foods**

Granola bars, crackers, trail mix, jerky. Individually wrapped preferred.

- **Baby formula & food**

Unopened and unexpired. Critical for families displaced from their homes.

CLOTHING & PERSONAL PROTECTION

- **Dry socks — wool or synthetic**

One of the most requested items in any flood event.

- **Waterproof work gloves**

For cleanup, debris handling, and field operations.

- **Rain ponchos**

Disposable or reusable. All sizes welcome.

- **Rubber boots**

Any size if available.

SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT

- **Heavy-duty garbage bags**

Large contractor-grade bags. Used for debris, belongings, and sandbag filling.

- **Tarps**

Any size. Blue or clear poly tarps for covering damaged structures.

- **Rope or paracord**

50+ feet preferred. Multiple field uses.

- **Flashlights & batteries**

AA and D cell most common. Headlamps are especially useful.

- **First aid supplies**

Bandages, antiseptic wipes, nitrile gloves, and medical tape.
